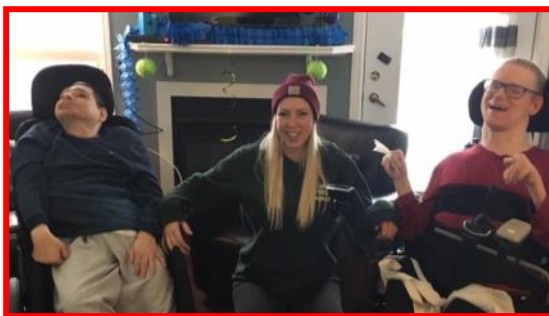
## Respecting the Past Living the Present Shaping the Future
